IMPORTANT INFORMATION

To the attention of the delegations participating in the 68th Challenge Licciardi
Junior Men's Foil World Cup

WELCOME TO AIX EN PROVENCE

The organizing committee of the Licciardi 2022 challenge wishes to welcome you in the best possible conditions, despite the many constraints linked to the pandemic situation.

To do this, we ask for your cooperation and your attention in following the instructions specified in this document.

We remind you that wearing a mask is compulsory as well as observing social distancing rules during the competition and throughout your stay.

1° CATERING Saturday and Sunday

There will be no snack bar in the gymnasium and it will be forbidden to eat inside the gymnasium.

A Food Truck and a little snack will be accessible outside in the immediate vicinity of the competition venue where it will be possible to buy drinks, coffee, sandwiches, etc.

2° ANTIGENIC TESTS

All participants (fencers, coaches, referees) must carry out an antigenic test prior to their accreditation (colored bracelet). This exam is provided by the organizer and the FIE and is free of charge to the participants.

These tests will take place on **Friday January 21 at the headquarters of the Escrime Pays d'Aix club, Maison des Arts de Combats, rue Henri Moisan.** (5 mins walk from the IBIS and OCEANIA hotels).

Following these tests, all fencers testing negative will immediately proceed to the nearby sale d'armes for the weapon control .

In order to respect the rules for social distancing and to avoid long waits, delegations will be invited to arrive in defined time slots. The time slots for each nation will be communicated and displayed in the hotels.

Please remember to bring the FIE forms annexes B and C, which will be checked beforehand.

For few fencers arriving late in Aix en Provence, it will be possible, on an exceptional basis only, to perform these tests on **Saturday January 22 from 6 a.m.** at the competition venue, **Gymnase Louison Bobet, 2 imp. Pratesi brothers 13090 Aix En Provence**

This few Fencers may go directly to the venue or by a special shuttle organized very early on Saturday morning from IBIS or Oceania .

In this case please register by mail (contact@escrime-paysdaix.fr) up to Thursday 20 January before 6pm local .

3° WEAPON CONTROL

The weapon control (**GLOVES, ELECTRIC JACKETS, MASKS**) will be open **Friday January 22, from 11 a.m.**, at the **Maison des Arts de Combat rue Henri Moissan 13090, Aix en Provence.** It is accessible only for fencers who have tested negative, and will immediately follow the health checks.

For fencers arriving late on Friday evening, weapon control will be possible only after negative antigenic test on Saturday morning directly at the venue, the Louison Bobet gymnasium.

4° REGISTRATION

Only one person per delegation or nation will be authorized to carry out the registration of the fencers on Friday January 21 at the counter provided for this purpose in the salle d'armes located at the house of combat arts rue Henri Moisan. **Registration must be made after the antigenic tests and the equipment check for all the fencers in the delegation are complete.**

5° SHUTTLE BETWEEN HOTELS and COMPETITION

Shuttles will only be run between the two official hotels, IBIS Val de l'ARC and OCEANIA, and the venue

- Saturday morning and evening
- Sunday morning

Shuttle times will be displayed in hotels.

- In addition, line 8 of the public bus system which departs from Val de l'Arc stops at Ibis , Oceania and near the Louison Bobet gymnasium. (Estimated bus journey time: 25 minutes)
